

Public Notice

The Department of Transportation and Public Works and the Puerto Rico Highway and Transportation Authority hereby notify to the public, private providers of transportation services and federal, state and municipal governments that the Puerto Rico Metropolitan Planning Organization (PRMPO) in the meetings held on March 19, 2019 approved the following documents:

- Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) for Fiscal Years 2020-2021

The UPWP includes planning activities, under Sections 5303 and 5304 that are eligible to be financed with funds from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). The UPWP must be approved by this Federal Agency.

- Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Fiscal Years 2019-2022

The TIP includes the programs and projects to improve the transit and highway system to be financed with funds from Federal Transit Administration and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), in the Urbanized Areas.


Furthermore, it notifies the availability of the Draft of the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for fiscal years 2019-2022. This document includes the programs and projects to improve the Islandwide transit and highway system to be financed with funds from FTA and FHWA. The STIP will be available for review and comments for a period of fifteen (15) calendar days from the date of this Notice.
